Finished Measurements

14cm x 10cm

Yarn

Hamanaka Bonny Yarn (Bulky weight, 100% Acrylic, 50g/60meters/66yards)

1 Skein in each color: 481 Grey (Body), 401 White (Belly), 478 Light Yellow (Beak and Boots), 401 Black (Eye embroidery)

Hooks

US G6 (4mm) Crochet Hook

Notions

Removable Stitch Markers

Stuffing

Tapestry Needle

Gauge

Gauge is not important for this project.

Abbreviations US Terms

Sc= single crochet

Sc2TOG= single crochet 2 stitches together

Inc= single crochet increase

Dec= single crochet decrease

Sts= stitches



Special Stitches

Inc: 2Sc in one stitch (one stitch increased)

Dec: Sc2TOG (one stitch decreased)

Instructions

Body

Using Grey yarn

Rnd 1: Work 6 Sc into Magic Ring. 6 sts.

Rnd 2: Inc around. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: (Sc, inc) repeat 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: (Sc 2, inc) repeat 6 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 5: (Sc 3, inc) repeat 6 times. 30 sts.

Rnd 6: (Sc 4, inc) repeat 6 times. 36 sts.

Rnd 7: (Sc 5, inc) repeat 6 times. 42 sts.

Rnds 8-23: Sc around. (16 rounds)

Rnd 24: (Sc 5, dec) repeat 6 times. 36 sts.

Rnd 25: (Sc 4, dec) repeat 6 times. 30 sts.

Rnd 26: (Sc 3, dec) repeat 6 times. 24 sts.

Rnd 27: (Sc 2, dec) repeat 6 times. 18 sts.

Stuff firmly before proceeding.

Rnd 28: (Sc, dec) repeat 6 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 29: Dec around. 6 sts.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Wings: (Make two)

Using Grey yarn

Rnd 1: Work 6 Sc into Magic Ring. 6 sts.

Rnd 2: Inc around. 12 sts.

Rnds 3-7: Sc around. (5 rounds)

Flatten, do not stuff. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Tail:

Using Grey yarn

Rnd 1: Work 6 Sc into Magic Ring. 6 sts

Rnd 2: Sc around. 6 sts

Rnd 3: (Sc 2, inc) repeat 2 times. 8 sts.

Rnd 4: (Sc 3, inc) repeat 2 times. 10 sts.

Rnd 5: (Sc 4, inc) repeat 2 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 6: (Sc 5, inc) repeat 2 times. 14 sts.

Flatten, do not stuff. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Belly

Using White yarn

Rnd 1: Work 6 Sc into Magic Ring.

Rnd 2: Inc around. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: (Sc, inc) repeat 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: (Sc 2, inc) repeat 6 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 5: (Sc 3, inc) repeat 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnd 6: (Sc 4, inc) repeat 6 times. 36 sts.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Beak

Using Light Yellow yarn

Rnd 1: Work 4 Sc into Magic Ring.

Rnd 2: (Sc, inc) repeat 2 times. 6 sts.

Rnd 3: (Sc 2, inc) repeat 2 times. 8 sts.

Flatten, do not stuff. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Boots: (Make two)

Using Light Yellow yarn

Rnd 1: Work 6 Sc into Magic Ring. 6 sts.

Rnd 2: Inc around. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: (Inc, Sc 5) repeat 2 times. 14 sts.

Rnd 4: Sc around.

Rnd 5: (2 dec, Sc 3) repeat 2 times. 10 sts.

Rnds 6-7: Sc around. (2 rounds)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff firmly.

Black yarn, embroider eyes, one stitch away from the beak, as two vertical lines from Rnd 8 to Rnd 9. Sew the belly between Rnds 11 and 22, right under the beak. Sew the arms onto the sides of the body on Rnd 13, about 4-5 stitches away from the belly. Sew the boots between Rnds 23 and 24 so the penguin looks like he is sitting. Position the boots so they point out a bit. Weave in all ends.

Finishing

Using pictures as reference, sew beak onto Rnd 10. Using
